I also thank the parishioners who have offered food items for the Good Shepherd Refugee; these donations will help them to serve the larger downtown area.

As you might know, we had been awaiting a family from Iraq as of this past January; however (as in the case of many other parishes and faith communities) the greater Syrian Refugee focus by the government put certain quotas on refugees from other countries. Happily that family was indeed sponsored elsewhere because of that delay. The Office of Refugees for the Archdiocese is working closely with us, at the present time, to bring over another family from Iraq. The Refugee Committee of this parish and I met to sign off on this plan and the next step is that the government will now work to further screen and assist this family. This obviously will take time. Sadly, this is the reality of the world today and how this process works. It is slow and often frustrating. However, we are committed and willing to wait since it is important to assist these families in need. I am very inspired by the dedication of our parish Refugee Committee who have been so patient in spite of the slow and often frustrating process. It is our firm belief that all of this is not about us, but about helping others in Please pray for the family we will be looking at sponsoring (a mother, father and three children). We had initial contact with them and we will continue to keep you updated. This is all in God's hands as well and so we pray that God will bless our good works in this regard.

In conclusion, let us remember one another in prayer.

SACRAMENT REGISTRATIONS

Please bring a photocopy of your child's baptismal certificate; if you do not have one, simply contact the parish where your child was baptized and they will provide you an updated one.

CONFIRMATION

Parents/Guardians who wish to register their children for the Sacrament of Confirmation are <u>required</u> to attend a Registration and Information Session at the Church on:

THURSDAY, OCTOBER 27th, at 7 p.m.

Parents are asked to bring with them a copy of the student's baptismal certificate. If unable to find one, simply contact the church where the child was baptized and they will provide you an updated one.

At each of the Registration Nights, Fr. Pat will outline the program of study for the respective schools, and the program for those attending public schools. For students attending public schools, classes will be held at the parish church; a schedule for those classes will be provided to the parents at the Registration Night. There will be some option of dates for the celebration of the Sacraments and parents will be asked to sign up for the dates which best suit them at the Registration Nights.
