## 31st Sunday in Ordinary Time

SAINT PAUL PRAYS for the Thessalonians, and also for us, that God will make us worthy. Sometimes we think we deserve everything we want, so we need the reminder that everything is gift, and that it is only by God's gift that we are made worthy to be the children of God.

The Book of Wisdom explains why this is so astounding, acknowledging that we are part of a vast universe. When we say that God is great, that greatness comes from God's care for us, who are "the speck that tips the scales." Tiny though we are, we are offered divine love for free, like handfuls of candy. Too often we just don't get it, and we sit hungry in the midst of a rich feast of grace. And when we don't get it, it is good to hear Jesus in the gospel showing the lengths to which God will go to make us worthy: "the Son of Man came to seek out and to save the lost."

But why did Jesus call Zacchaeus? Weren't there other worthy tax collectors around? Jesus saw how Zacchaeus worked past his own limitations in order to have an encounter with Jesus.
