Dear Parishioners:

Thank you for your patience with the construction in the parking lot and all that it demands of everyone. As you know, we are not simply putting asphalt down; it is much more complicated. The pulling away of the old asphalt revealed that there was no gravel underneath. Tests done on the condition of the soil underneath revealed that it had a high salt content. Because of this, the soil was considered environmentally contaminated; thus, it could not be mixed with any new soil and had to be all dug up and taken to a refinement centre in Uxbridge. That put us back since it meant many trucks had to go back and forth for a week or so to cart the old soil away. An additional drainage pipe is being added and connected to catch basins to assist in removing ground water build up and "one" catch basin and the pipe into it had to be replaced. Secondly, after removing the soil, a number of drainage and sewage pipes had to be repaired, as many were broken. Various areas of sub-grade had been identified by our Geo-Technical Consultant as being too soft for placement of granular sub-base. Placement of granular sub-base over soft sub-grade would result in premature failure of the finished asphalt surface. To address the areas of soft sub-grade it was decided to place Geogrid to bridge the soft areas in lieu of extra depth excavation and replacement. The Geogrid is placed directly over the prepared (but soft) sub-grade prior to placement of the granular sub-base. As such, this is why the parking lot is taking some extra time to finish, not to mention the heavy rains, and even other rains that have stopped construction.

The construction will also include the repair of current curbing, new curbing and the addition of a new accessibility location by the green space at the back of the church. As you know, we will be installing new light poles with LED lighting. The old poles have all been removed and temporary lighting has been put up during the time of construction. New light poles are on order and will take a bit longer to install so the temporary ones will be present until the new ones arrive. The driveway by the front of the church will be widened and sidewalks will be added to each of the side entrances of the church. All of this was previously outlined in the drawings made available to you; a larger drawing is located on the wall of the parish in the hallway which leads towards the rear entrance.

During the weekdays, parishioners have been so supportive in having daily Mass at St. Cyril School, where parking is provided. I am grateful to all for your patience. As you know, this project is sponsored, in part, by the Family of Faith Campaign. During that campaign, I had outlined a few goals as we moved forward: Parking Lot, Youth Ministry, Ministry to Seniors, and interior of the church (new flooring, etc.). I am pleased that we have moved fairly quickly on implementing the first three parts of our goal.

In closing, I trust this information is helpful, and I will continue to keep you informed. Thank you for your support and prayers.
