Resurrection of the Lord

READING TODAY'S GOSPEL, on this most holy day, I marvel at Mary Magdalene's tenacity in seeking Jesus and her transformation when she sees his promise fulfilled.

As you hear the Gospel proclaimed, imagine her blinding grief. She watched her beloved Rabbi being tortured, witnessed his crucifixion and now finds his tomb empty. Notice how Mary comes so early in the morning that it is still dark and she is the only one there. How greatly must she love him to go to the tomb alone, unafraid when all the others were?

Her faith is a wondrous thing. Even in grief and bewilderment, Mary stays by the empty tomb in the hope of finding out what happened to Jesus. Jesus appears to her first, to announce his resurrection before he has even fully ascended.

Don't we all encounter these moments in our life, moments when we need God but do not feel his presence? Mary Magdalene's unwavering faith teaches us discipleship, that if we seek him with love and faith, we will find him. Mary's faith transforms her grief to joy when she is the first to meet Jesus, eventually becoming an apostle to the apostles.

This Easter, remember we are here to rejoice in a promise fulfilled and in the transformative power of God who draws us close to him in love.

Blessing of the Sacred Heart Altar

In addition, a marble Ambo (pulpit) is being designed to match the altar; this is being donated by a family in the parish, in memory of their parents. The current wooden altar will be moved to the Marian Shrine of the Pieta, thus remaining in the Church.

All are invited to this very historic moment in the life of our parish, especially as we continue to celebrate our 75th Anniversary year. This gift of the marble altar further links us in a spiritual way to the Cathedral Basilica of our Archdiocese.

Fr. Michael Busch will celebrate the Mass and speak to the history of the altar as well as the Relics contained within it.
