He got up instantly and, abandoning work, home and all social connections, hastily packed and led the child and mother away to safety.

To protect his child he chose to give up everything and become a refugee in a strange land. Such is the protective instinct of parents.

All parents want what Saint Joseph wanted – a safe home for their children. Some are forced to flee danger and become refugees, as he did. Others are more fortunate, and can stay in their homes and protect their children by ensuring them clean air, pure water, nourishing food, good education and a future filled with hope.

For parents, Saint Joseph offers a perfect lesson in parenting – take care of your children.
