SUNDAY OF THE WORD OF GOD January 24, 2021

Sunday of the Word of God has been designated by Pope Francis as a special day devoted to the celebration, study and dissemination of Scripture. It is intended to encourage the people of God to become more familiar with the Bible and to learn to pray with it.

The Pope wrote of the role of the Holy Spirit in opening our hearts to the "inspired, dynamic, and spiritual characther of the sacred text." Without the work of the Spirit, he writes, there would be a risk of remaining limited to the written text alone, which could lead to a "fundamentalist reading, which needs to be avoided."

The Bible is a collection of religious "books" written by dozens of authors over the hundreds of years. The writers used many types of literature (poetry, legend, myth, laws and commentary, preaching, parable) to express their understanding of the meaning of human life and the role of God in our lives. None of the books is intended to be a simple recounting of events, like a newspaper report or a history book. Our challenge is not to wonder what happened, but to discover the lesson that the author was trying to express through the writing...

....God was involved in the long process of the Jewsish and Christan people slowly growing in their understanding of life and God's role in their lives. What was expressed by an author in 1000 BCE is not the final word; neither is what was expressed by the authors of the Gospels. That process has continued through centuries of Tradition, and must continue today.

Meditating about any Bible passage all by ourselves runs the risk, as the Pope wrote, of being confined to a limited perspective. A vist to the Novalis website (https://en.novalis.ca/) could provide a good starting point for reading what others think about the Bible, and on that basis opening our hearts to the work of the Holy Spirit. It can be unwise to search the internet on our own for information about the Bible.

because many online sites are fundamentalist, tending to take every biblical story literally.

In seeking to become more familiar with the Bible, we might take the four readings that have been chosen for Mass each Sunday, learn about them for a couple of days each, and pray with them.

In reflecting on any Bible passage, we consider what we ask of God and what we ask of ourselves. God isn't going to 'magically' stop the pandemic or relieve extreme political situations, or indeed reverse the inevitable in our own personal lives. What we can ask of God is wisdom to help us understand the meaning of events in our lives and in our world. Our search for wisdom and meaning takes place in a context of unconditional love. God is Love and the power of God is the power of Love. We are loved, no matter what happens to us, and no matter what we do. What we ask of ourselves is integrity; we ask God to help us to be true to ourselves in all our decisions.

O most watchful Guardian of the Holy Family, defend the chosen children of Jesus Christ; O most loving father, ward off from us every contagion of error and corrupting influence; O most mighty protector, be kind to us and from heaven assist us in our struggle with the power of darkness.

As once you rescued the Child Jesus from deadly peril, so now protect God's Holy Church from the snares of the enemy and from all adversity; shield, too, each one of us by your constant protection, so that, supported by your example and your aid, we may be able to live piously, to die in holiness, and to obtain eternal happiness in heaven. Amen.
