6th SUNDAY OF EASTER

WE LIVE IN an unpredictable world. We can never know how things will turn out or how people will react to our words. We cant't be sure what tomorrow will be and because of painful experiences we've had amidst a world of flux, we can become afraid. We begin to fear losing control over our lives, to fear the criticism of others and to fear unexpected injury of loss.

How should we respond to this fear? How ought we as Christians encounter the unknown future? Our temptation can be to maintain a sense of control. We do this in a thousand different ways: by seeking to manipulate others, by hoarding our goods for potentioal future need, by building barriers between ourselves and strangers or those who remind us of our vulnerability. But the truth is that we don't need to protect ourselves from the harshness of an unpredictable world.

Today God reminds us that we need not fear at all, because He is sovereign and He loves us. God chose freely to create all that exists out of love and He sustains us in existence out of that same love.

Love is the driving force of the universe. All we need to do is entrust ourselves to providence, to this current of grace. Today, Jesus gives us the simple solution to fear: "Abide in my love."

Confessions are by appointment only; kindly email the parish to request an appointment. Funerals, weddings, and baptisms, can be held with a limit of 10 people (including priest and possible server).

On weekends, the Saturday 4:30 p.m. Mass (ONLY) will be live-streamed in order to accommodate the Communion Services on Sunday. However, this live-streamed Mass can be viewed all weekend through the parish website. A FLOCK NOTE message will be sent to all parishioners, via email, each Tuesday which will link you to the EVENT BRITE schedule for the times of the weekend communion services. Keep in mind, each service is limited to 8 persons (the presider and the person who greets you on arrival complete the number 10 capacity per service). The Communion services will be held every 15 minutes, each lasting about 5-7 minutes. This provides the opportunity for people to arrive and leave in a safer way. Parishioners must register in advance and no walkins are permitted.

Thank you for your patience and understanding as we continue to do our best to serve you in these most challenging times. Let us pray for one another and for an end to the pandemic.
