#### THE MOST HOLY TRINITY SUNDAY



#### TRINITY SUNDAY

ST. MATTHEW TELLS us that en route to a special meeting with Jesus 40 days after His resurrection, some of the disciples doubted. Yes, God's family members do doubt; sitting in Mass we too might question Jesus' omnipotence.

How then did so many disciples come to be martyred for proclaiming the Christian Gospel? What shifted Jesus'followiers from doubt to death-defying evangelization? Jesus answerede their doubts and questions by acknowledging the Holy Trinity.

The disciples needed to know who Jesus was, what they were to do, and where He would be when they needed Him. Jesus, as God the Son, told them of His authority in heaven and on earth. Then, speaking for God the Father, He counselled them to go to all people and make them disciples as well, baptizing them into, and teaching them the ways of, God the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. "I am with you always..." was Jesus' reassurance of His constant presence, prefiguring the coming of God the Holy Spirit at Penrecost.

Jesus came near to His eleven on a mountain to reveal the might of the Trinity – in the same way Jesus comes near to us in Holy Eucharist, to reassure and empower us by the Three in One and One in Three. Today are we prepared for Christ Jesus' *missa* meeting, His sending us out into the world, for Mass? (Reflection of Beverly Illaug, of Living with Christ)

#### CHURCH SCHEDULE DURING LOCK-DOWN

The Church will be closed for daily Mass during the lock-down. Msgr. Pat and Fr. Dave will continue to offer Mass, which you can access virtually through our parish website at: http://www.stedward.ca

Confessions are by appointment only; kindly email the parish to request an appointment. Funerals, weddings, and baptisms, can still be held with a limit of 10 people (including priest and possible server).

On weekends, the Saturday 4:30 p.m. Mass (ONLY) will be live-streamed in order to accommodate the Communion Services on Sunday. However, this live-streamed Mass can be viewed all weekend through the parish website. A FLOCK NOTE message will be sent to all parishioners, via email, each Tuesday which will link you to the EVENT BRITE schedule for the times of the weekend communion services. Keep in mind, each service is limited to 8 persons (the presider and the person who greets you on arrival complete the number 10 capacity per service). The Communion services will be held every 15 minutes, each lasting about 5-7 minutes. This provides the opportunity for people to arrive and leave in a safer way. Parishioners must register in advance and no walk-ins are permitted.

Thank you for your patience and understanding as we continue to do our best to serve you in these most challenging times. Let us pray for one another and for an end to the pandemic.
