18th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

HUMANS MUST CONSTANTLY strive to know, serve and love God. This is never easy, for it is difficult to accept one's lot in life. As we see in today's readings, people of faith often complain about being abandoned by God, as when, in the first reading, Moses leads the hungry people out of Egypt. But God provides manna and eventually safe passage.

What does the Lord ask in return? We must learn to surrender and trust in His divine mercy. In our frenetic world it is too easy for us to forget to pray and foster a relationship with Christ. When hardship strikes, we can turn inward and be resentful towards God instead of reaching out to him. We can become alienated and distanced from God because our hearts have hardened.

The bread from heaven we receive today is the grace that flows from meditating on the Word. But with patience and faith in Christ, we can eventually centre ourselves so that our words, thoughts and actions are based on our innate experience of God.

Only Christ can help us shed our old selves, the unbelieving aspect of our being, and take on a new self – one that trusts Jesus to soften our hearts and to accept that He is with us no matter what our life's circumstances.
