30th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

THE READINGS TODAY present a vision of praise and gratitude. Psalm 126 is one of the 15 psalms of ascent that were sung by Jews as they "ascended" the stairs of the Temple three times annually to celebrate their festivals. Verse five notes, "May those who sow in tears reap with shouts of joy." And it is with heartfelt cries of joy that we are able to acknowledge Jesus the Christ as High Priest and Saviour in the Letter to the Hebrews.

An example of Jesus' compassionate dealings with sinners and those who suffer is seen in today's Gospel. His interaction with Bartimaeus, the blind beggar, reflects Jesus' love for the forgotten members of His body. The beggar refuses to be silenced, so great is his distress. His faith surpasses all humiliation or fear of rejection. "What do you want me to do for you?" "Let me see again."

What does the beggar want to see? What do we want to see again? What would we answer to Jesus' simple question. "What do you want me to do for you?" It is a daunting thought that the Son of God would ask us this question. What will your answer be? Today, on World Mission Sunday, let us renew our commitment to spreading the Good News in our towns, cities, country and beyond. (Reflection of Marilyn Elplick of Living with Christ)

SACRAMENT REGISTRATIONS

Starting this weekend, we shall begin accepting registrations for the Sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Communion, for students in Grade 2, who are attending one of our parish Catholic schools, or public and private schools.

As well, parents of students in Grade 7 may register their children who wish to be prepared for the Sacrament of Confirmation.

Registrations will be available on our parish website: http://stedwardtheconfessorno.archtotonto.org. Please be sure to read the Registration Form carefully and to fill in all the required information. You will also need to submit, with the form, a copy of the child's Catholic Baptism certificate.

Registration Forms must be received by <u>November 15th</u>. Following the registration deadline, all registered parents will receive a special notice by email, inviting them to a Parent Webinar (one webinar for First Communion; a separate one for Confirmation) to review with Msgr. Pat the plan for 2022. At that time, Msgr. Pat will review the dates that will be made available for the celebration of the Sacraments at the parish. These details are also mentioned on the Registration Form, and its covering letter.

Students attending private or public schools will be required to take a virtual course through the parish. The schedule of classes will be announced at the Parent Webinar.

Students in the Catholic schools affiliated with our parish will receive their instruction during regular class time; Msgr. Pat and seminarian, Jeremy Zou, will also be involved in this teaching, along with the Grade 2 and Grade 7 teachers.

Again, all information on how to register, what is required, and the flow of the program are contained on the Registration Form. Please be sure to read it carefully before submitting it.

Let us pray for all students preparing to receive these important sacraments in the coming year.
