Synod on Synodality

St. Edward's Parishioners to Take Part in a Synod Survey

Dear Parishioners:

Last year (2021) Pope Francis initiated a two-year Synod, inviting all laity to offer their feedback on the Church. Pope Francis wishes to "listen" to your thoughts and input. A formal survey has been prepared and is available in the parish lobby on a specifically identified table. Surveys were distributed after all Masses last weekend to parishioners

However, as mentioned last weekend, we will also have two other options: an in person meeting of small groups, and a ZOOM meeting for those who wish to meet on line. A FlockNote was sent to all parishioners with registration details. Each of these options allow for reflection in small groups, as well as an opportunity to fill in the survey forms anonymously.

Once the surveys are returned to the parish, they are then sent to the local Archdiocese, who will send them to the Canadian Bishop's Conference, and then they go to Rome. This is an international Synod, and so the Holy Father, Pope Francis, is engaging the whole world. This is a great opportunity for him to listen to your voice and the voices of all the laity within the church. Let us support Pope Francis in this important process. Thank you!
