16th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

IMAGES OF HOSPITALITY and ease in relationship with God are interwoven through today's readings. Receptive, generous and gracious in service to the Lord, Abraham models hospitality as a spiritual practice. In return, he receives an unexpected blessing. To the psalmist, those who "abide" in God are in word and act virtuous, loving, honest, affirming, just and respectful. Like Abraham, they model God whom they serve.

The story of Mary, Martha and Jesus in Luke's Gospel is familiar to us - Mary, the receptive listener at Jesus' feet and her sister, Martha, the practical hostess busy in the background. In fact, the sisters have been distinguished by tradition as models of different types of spiritual expression: Mary, contemplation and Martha, action.

We can identify with the encounter and see ourselves in them. Yet, in light of the other readings, we realize the central focus of their gathering is not simply entertainment but discipleship itself.

Disciples are called, says Paul, to make the word of God fully known, the word which is Christ in them. The one thing needed by mary, Martha and all disciples is immersion in Jesus' person, an "at-homeness" in relationship with Him that enables us to reflect His presence, His hospitality, His reverence for all. So, transformed, we can be His eyes, His hands, His heart every day.

Dear Parishioners:

As summers go, this July will be filled with many activities.

Firstly, next week we start the Totus Tuus Summer Camp, which is an annual Summer Camp, held at St. Edward's Church. The day program (for kids entering Grades 1-6) is full (close to 60 students). The night program (for youth entering Grades 7-12) has a higher number than usual with about 35 youth. Please keep all the volunteers and teachers in your prayers. The four teachers (called Missionaries) will be the main leaders. These two young men and two young women are part of the Archdiocesan Youth Ministry and went through much training and faith-development before coming to St. Edward's. A special word of gratitude to our seminarianintern, Jeremy Zou, who has done a marvelous job in coordinating the Camp and arranging for all the volunteers.

Secondly, I am delighted to inform that our former seminarian-intern, Sean Jacob, will be ordained to the transitional diaconate this Sunday, July 17th, at Christ the king Parish in Mississauga, at 5:30 p.m. by His Eminence Thomas Cardinal Collins. All are welcome to attend his Ordination. It will be live-streamed.

Sean will preach at all the weekend Masses, at St. Edward's, the following weekend, July $23^{rd}/24^{th}$. As such, many of you can greet him after any of the Masses. Please pray for him and his family.

Thirdly, as you are well aware, the Holy Father, Pope Francis is coming to Canada (July 24^{th} – July 29^{th}), in response to his desire to bring healing and reconciliation in light of the suffering of the Indigenous people during their years at Residential Schools.

We will have a special prayer card designed so that during his visit we may be united in prayer. A banner, with the prayer, will hang in our church.

Finally, please note that our current seminarian, Jeremy Zou, will be concluding his year of internship on July $30^{\text{th}}/31^{\text{st}}$ weekend. He will speak at all the Masses; more information on his final weekend will be forthcoming.

In conclusion, please know of my gratitude for all your prayers and support. I also hope you will have more time to enjoy the summer.
