## 23<sup>rd</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time

TODAY'S GOSPEL DELIVERS a sobering message. Jesus is at the height of His popularity because of the miracles the crowds are witnessing and the wisdom He is imparting as He teaches. The throng realizes this person is unique and claims to be the son of God. As more people listen to Him, Jesus drops a bombshell: you cannot be a followers if you don't renounce everything and everyone else. That's straight blackand-white talk.

I think back to a hymn we sang 50 years ago at a prayer meeting. It was rousing with simple, meaningful lyrics. Though none go with me, I still will follow...the world behind me, the cross before me. After singing that hymn, I began to ponder the words. I meant what I was singing, Jesus had to become my focus, my purpose for living, and the centre of all my thoughts and actions. My allegiance was to Christ and no other. Jesus had to become much more than my Sunday hour at Mass. That's quite the commitment.

This responsibility to make Jesus our cornerstone can be daunting and solitary. However, our focus on the challenge has to be coupled with a trust that we are not alone in making this commitment. provide the grace and faith we need to follow Him.

# IMPORTANT INFORMATION ON PROPOSED TEMPORARY ACCOMMODATIONS PLAN FOR TORONTO REFUGEES

On August 15, 2022, Toronto City Council approved the creation of more than 600 new emergency shelter spaces for refugees and refugee claimants by approving the recommendation by City staff to execute an agreement with the hotel at 3 Park Home Ave. in North York. The site is now planned to open in October 2022.

Sojourn House will be the operator of the refugee program at 3 Park Home Ave. Sojourn House has 30+ years of experience providing Emergency Shelter and Transitional Supportive Housing services to newly arrived refugees coming from all parts of the world. Sojourn House already operates sites in Toronto that provide a safe place and an inclusive environment to people who have had the refugee experience. Sojourn House is dedicated to providing the best possible settlement services and programs that help residents transition and integrate into the community.

Supports provided at 3 Park Home Ave. will be based on individual needs, and will include help with the settlement process and case coordination with legal services, assistance with finding permanent housing, employment and education supports, and referrals to healthcare and mental health supports, and other community services. Recreation activities will also be offered on-site to engage residents and children. In addition, the City has made contact with the Toronto District School Board and Toronto Catholic District School Board to help support the children and youth at the site to smoothly transition into local schools.
