
A Thanksgiving Prayer

28th Sunday in Ordinary Time

AS I WRITE this, much of the world is in social isolation due to COVID-19. Like lepers of old, we are all acting as though we are unclean: masking, social and physical distancing, and taking purifying baths at our sinks or handsanitizing stations to protect each other from a deadly virus. For the first time perhaps, the majority of the members of our society know the devastating impact of social isolation. COVID-19 also exposed other kinds of isolation and marginalization in our world that have been hidden in plain sight. The dvnamic of foreigner/insider, marginalized/included, unworthy/worthy, privileged/disadvantaged has been made clear.

Jesus upended those dynamics, healing and outsider. Jesus welcomed the former leper, but I wonder whether the broader community welcomed him. He was, after all, still a Samaritan.

What are the dynamics of marginalization/inclusion in our contemporary religious communities? Who seeks healing? Who is isolated, for what sins or sicknesses, ethnic or gender identities, personal histories? Pope Francis makes clear. "The Eucharist is not a prize for the perfect, but a powerful medicine and nourishment for the weak" (Evangelii Gaudium, 47). If we're honest, that's all of us. We all need this medicine that forms "true bonds of solidarity" (Pope Francis, Twitter, 14 June 2020). Come. Give thanks. Eat. (Reflection of Bernadette Gasslein of Living with Christ)

Are you able to host a Ukrainian family?

When hearing reports of the war in Ukraine, and the millions of Ukrainians that have been forced to flee their homeland, many have asked what they can do to help. Over 80,000 Ukrainians have already arrived to Canada through a special visa program created by Immigration Canada. An additional 500,000 have applied to the program and are expected to arrive in the coming months. Many are arriving to Toronto and are without family here in Canada to help them. Among those will be some who are vulnerable to human trafficking, particularly seniors, single women, and women with children. There is an immediate need for families to host for a period of between one and six months some of those who have arrived. <u>Pakistan Floods – Humanitarian Relief</u>

Devastating floods in Pakistan have displaced hundreds of thousands, at one point leaving a third of the country inundated with water. More than 1,500 people have died following record rainfall with 33 million throughout the country affected by this disaster.

Since June, Pakistan has experienced three times more rainfall than an average monsoon season. Flooding and landslides have destroyed homes, crops, health centres, roads and bridges.

There is an elevated risk of the spread of malaria, dengue fever and other diseases. Priorities include clean water, shelter and health care for those directly affected by this tragic situation.

The Archdiocese of Toronto will channel donations through Catholic partners (including Caritas Canada – Development and Peace as well as the Archdiocese of Karachi) to support relief efforts underway. Please note that these organizations are **not** subject to the government matching funds program.
