A MESSAGE FROM MSGR. PAT ANGEL TREE PROGRAM

In this bulletin you will find an update on the results of the Angel Tree Christmas Program. I wish to thank Marie Barry for her report on the Good Shepherd Ministries and the Families in Need report, and her diligence in assisting Good Shepherd Ministries in isolating specific items the homeless might need in terms of winter clothing and other necessities, and even personally shopping for them. I thank Mike Mastromatteo, and the whole team of the St. Vincent de Paul Society, for their report on the campaign, plus the annual collection which assists their good works on a daily basis. In addition, approximately 80 children from the Catholic Children's Aid were gifted with toys and gift cards from parishioners who took tags for that cause. The Families in Need campaign also assisted a newly arrived Ukrainian family fleeing from war, and another family in need.

It is especially inspiring to note that this campaign assists not only those associated within our parish boundaries, but includes the homeless in Toronto, and children under the care of Catholic Children's Aid. Finally, I thank all the volunteers who assisted in this campaign. I especially thank ALL our parishioners for your generosity in helping the less fortunate, so they may know of our prayers, support and compassion. Thank you!

The Society of Saint Vincent de Paul - Report

The members of the Society of Saint Vincent de Paul at St. Edward's parish thank all parishioners for their support of the conference over the past year and at Christmas.

During the year we visited 68 families in the parish, assisting 148 adults and 102 children with food, furnishings and accommodation aid. We sponsored one child for Marygrove camp.

Parishioners generously donate \$12,022 to the Christmas collection, and along with support for the Angel Tree program and St. Edward School Joy Campaign this allowed us to provide Christmas help to 50 families.

We also provided support over the year to the Society's residential housing programs, including St. Clare Residence women's shelter in Willowdale.

The members of St. Edward's conference thank you sincerely for your support in this ministry to the needy in our community.
