Dear Parishioners:

Firstly, I trust your summer is going well and providing you a time of rest and perhaps some family holidays.

The month of July, which has just concluded, was indeed a very active one here at the parish. For instance, we managed to host a very successful summer camp for the youth of the parish, entitled "Totus Tuus" (which means: "Totally Yours"). The day and evening programs were well attended and I thank all who assisted in any way.

As well, we bid a fond farewell to Alvin Joys, our seminarian-intern, who truly made a difference in the parish the past year in terms of his ministry to parishioners of all ages. In his final reflection at Mass, he shared with you his deep gratitude for all your prayers and support. As you know, he left a bit early to also attend World Youth Day, in Lisbon, Portugal, and took with him the intentions of all our parishioners to the Shrine of Our Lady of Fatima. Alvin will return to St. Augustine's Seminary, in September, to continue his studies and formation for the priesthood. In addition, we welcomed Daniel Lee, who came as a summer seminarian in residence. One of Daniel's other duties will be to work at the Office of Spiritual Affairs at the Archdiocese. Please keep him in your prayers. In fact, please pray for all the seminarians!

I wish to also update you briefly on the construction happening on the roof. As noted previously, the work is only contained to the flat part of the roof. This is still quite extensive in nature, and is demanding much time and labour. It is almost complete, and so we will inform you once it is concluded. The funding for this project is from the funds already accumulated by the parish during the Family of Faith campaign a few years ago. If you recall, we also repaired the parking lot, new lighting around the grounds, and installed handicapped access doors in the church and bathrooms. A second project being undertaken is the upgrades to the parish hall kitchen. This project is currently underway and we hope to have it completed by end of August. I know the social committee, and indeed all our parish groups, are looking forward to using the new kitchen.

In conclusion, as we enter the month of August, I look forward to seeing you at Mass, as well as the parish Food Festival and Picnic (August 13) and the special outdoor Mass for the Feast of the Assumption (August 15).
