She later witnessed the establishment of St. Edward the Confessor, on Yonge St., and the move to its current location on Churchill Avenue, in 1988.

Eileen also served as sacristan, and preparing flowers for the altar. Her deep faith inspired her husband to become Catholic and her son to enter the Seminary. While he did not become a priest, he led a faith filled life until his death.

Eileen currently resides at Amica and watches the Mass live-streamed. She was the first Catholic resident and now she interacts with many more. Msgr. Pat celebrates Mass there, once a month, and the Eucharistic Ministers take Holy Communion to the Catholic residents each week, which is a great treasure for her and them.
