CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD AND: THE LITTLE LAMBS MINISTRY

The Children's Liturgy of the Word and the Little Lambs Ministry are two distinct ministries, each on Sunday, for the children of the parish, which helps them to reflect on the Sunday scripture passages, each taught by committed and experienced teachers and leaders to whom we are most grateful. Here is how it works:

Parents/Guardians and their children are asked to attend the Sunday morning 9:30 a.m. Mass. Following the opening of the Mass, the priest will invite the teachers, parents and children to come to the front of the altar for a special blessing. Then they proceed down the aisle of the church and go to their respective classrooms, which is divided by ages. The teachers will lead the way.

The Little Lambs Ministry is for children, aged 4 years and under, and is held in the downstairs parish hall in the special classroom for children. Because of their age, at least one parent/guardian must accompany the child to the session.

The Children's Liturgy of the Word is for children 5 years and up (usually to age 7), and is held in the upstairs hall on the main level of the church. Parents do not need to accompany their children but are most welcome.

The class concludes once the priest in the church has completed the Prayers of the Faithful and the preparation for the Offertory begins. Then the parents, children and teachers re-join the parish mass so they may be there for the Offertory and Communion. Keep in mind that parents and children may also wish to remain in the main hall as the Mass is live-streamed to the parish hall. Communion is brought to the hall by the priest.

Both ministries are looking for enthusiastic and interested volunteers (high school students up to adults) to help with the programs. Screening is required. For the Children's Liturgy of the Word please contact Martin Yeung at:


