**BAPTISM OF THE LORD** 

GOD IS EVER-PRESENT to His people. After the Fall, He sent a line of prophets with insstructions and encouragement. You will receive Jesus' forgiveness and the Holy Spirit, taking the place Jesus has prepared for you in the Body of Christ. Remember the way the Father looks at Jesus today. He looks at you the same way and sees His beloved child.

# **ORDINARY JUBILEE OF THE YEAR 2025**

This year our Christmas celebrations was informed by the Jubilee Year in which Pope Francis launched and invites us to share, inspired by the theme "*Pilgrims of Hope*". Jubilee Years ordinarily happen every twentyfive years and are meant to be a time of great spiritual renewal and reconciliation. Our Holy Father announced the Jubilee expressing his desire that "the Jubilee be a moment of genuine, personal encounter with the Lord Jesus, the "door" (cf.Jn 10:7-9) of our salvation, whom the Church is charged to proclaim always everywhere and to all as "our hope" (1 Tim 1:1).

On Christmas Eve, Pope Francis inaugurated the Jubilee Year with the official opening of the Holy Door of Saint Peter's Basilica, continuing until January 6, 2026, with the closing of the Holy Door.

As in the past, the Archdiocese has identified holy places of worship in each of the major regions of the archdiocese to serve as pilgrimage destinations during the Jubilee Year. For the Central Region, St. Edward the Confessor Parish, North York is one of the parishes that has been selected.
