

WE ARE VULNERABLE people. We are dependent and needy and poor. We can wrap ourselves round with comforts, but we can't change the fact that we're adrift in a chaotic world. We cannot survive on our own. And that is terrifying, if we're willing to admit it.

There is an old legend that the mother pelican, in times of famine when she couldn't find food for her young, would feed them in a gruesome, albeit beautiful way. Unable to provide food from her surroundings, she would peck at her breast until her flesh tore, and then she would feed them with her blood. St. Thomas Aquinas alludes to this old legend in his hymn to Jesus in the Eucharist, *Adoro te devote*, comparing this ultimate love of the pelican for her children with the love of Christ for His people.

Jesus does not leave His children to fend for themselves. He is not satisfied to let the crowd from today's Gospel go into town to find food. Rather, He wants to provide immediately, miraculously, for their needs, telling His apostles, "you give them something to eat." God feeds His people. He provides for us abundantly. He feeds you today with His very self, with His Body and His Blood.

"That Blessed Upper Room" Pastoral Letter from Frank Cardinal Leo

Frank Cardinal Leo, Metropolitan Archbishop of Toronto, has released "*That Blessed Upper Room*," a pastoral letter inviting the faithful of the archdiocese to reflect together on the significance of The Upper Room in our lives, our families and in our communities of faith as this story is so directly connected to pivotal events in the life of Jesus and of the early Church. The letter is divided into nine chapters, drawing on dimensions of our Catholic Christian life. In the words of Cardinal Leo:

"This resource can be the object of a parish sharing group or an informal gathering of friends. The reflections can be used as inspiration for summer reading or for Advent or Lenten activities or for a personal retreat. You can, for instance, take one question per day and let it accompany you or set some quiet time per week, a short 15 minutes, to read a paragraph and ask yourself a question that is proposed. Studied and reflected upon individually or in community, whether in families, parishes, schools and religious houses, I pray that this small contribution will help readers and faithful come to a more profound sense of faith, a more mature relationship with the Lord and to a transforming experience of grace."
