#### Dear Parishioners:

It is hard to believe how fast the summer months have flown by! I hope you had a relaxing and peaceful summer, perhaps simply spending more quality time with family and friends.

Although some of the programs at St. Edward's took a break over the summer, St. Edward's still remained quite busy and active. While the regular schedule of daily Masses, confessions, baptisms, Holy Hours, weekend Masses, and senior home masses continued, summer also produced a steadier schedule of weddings, preparation meetings for the RCIA, and many other events. Some of these included the International Picnic and Barbecue, which drew over 400 people, the Corpus Christi Procession, and the Totus Tuus Summer Camp, which was a great success and filled to capacity. During the camp, we also celebrated daily Mass for the youth. A highlight of the summer was also the outdoor Mass on the Solemnity of the Assumption of Mary (August 15). A special initiative this year, given the designation of the parish as a Pilgrim Parish for the Jubilee Year of Hope, we welcomed a number of pilgrims from various parishes for mass and confessions. More pilgrims are expected throughout the rest of the year. It continues to be a unique pleasure for Fr. Andrew, and I, to host the pilgrims, to provide a history of the parish, and to celebrate the sacraments with them. Some came in bus groups, others in smaller groups and even some came individually. Among those visiting in recent weeks: the Hispanic Catholic community, the Chinese and Filipino communities, and the Toronto council, Development and Peace. Some pilgrims even travelled from the States!

The Knights of Columbus and I also designed a new spiritual program for the men of the parish, entitled "COR" which will begin in October. More details will be announced shortly.

This weekend, in recognition of the canonizations, in Rome, of both Blessed Carlo Acutis, and Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati, we will have special prayer intentions. As you know, St. Edward's was privileged this summer to host relics of both future saints during a weekend Mass. Many people came forward to be blessed. This weekend, let us join in prayer with the universal Church as Pope Leo XIV canonizes these two young saints, wonderful models of faith especially for the youth.

As we begin this new school year, I wish to invite your prayers for all the students, teachers, principals and staff of our parish schools as we engage another year of studies and faith formation. As you know, our parish schools include: St. Antione-Daniel, St. Cyril, St. Edward the

Confessor, and Cardinal Carter Academy for the Arts. The principals, and I, met the last week of August to plan the school Masses and events for the coming year. It is important to note that both Fr. Andrew, and I, celebrate Masses on a regular basis in all our schools. I am very grateful for the warm and engaging relationship with the schools. It is an important aspect of our ministry to build on the family of faith between the home, the parish, and the schools. I feel blessed to have such wonderful principals, vice-principals, and teachers in our parish schools. I am also grateful for their support and encouragement in supporting our efforts in youth ministry as we connect students from the school with the parish programs such as EDGE and LIFE TEEN.

Finally, I wish to congratulate our former seminarianintern, Matthew Tulio, who will be ordained a deacon on Saturday, September 13, at St. Michael's Cathedral-Basilica. The Ordination Mass will be held at 10:00 a.m. All are welcome to attend. Deacon Matthew will then attend, same day, the 4:30 p.m. Saturday evening Mass at St. Edward the Confessor, to give thanks for your support during his internship year. His plan, at the moment, is to also attend the Sunday Masses. You are welcome, following the Saturday evening Mass, to the parish hall for a time of social and to congratulate Deacon Matthew.

The other exciting news, related to vocations, is that His Eminence Frank Cardinal Leo, the Archbishop of Toronto, is appointing a new seminarian-intern, John Xerri, to St. Edward's Parish, for the coming year. John is from Malta. His seminary in Malta, and St. Augustine's Seminary, in Toronto, have worked out a special year of internship for John, with the approval of His Eminence. More details will follow, but I wish to thank His Eminence, and the Rector of St. Augustine's Seminary, Fr. Scott Birchall, for their trust and confidence in sending seminarian-interns to St. Edward's Parish. It is indeed a unique blessing to have the witness of these men who speak of God's transforming presence in their lives. It helps us to look at how God is there for us as well.

In closing, let us pray for one another in this Jubilee Year of Hope. God bless you!

### <u>Frank Cardinal Leo Appointed</u> <u>Member of Vatican's Dicastery for the Clergy</u>

On August 28, 2025, it was announced that Frank Cardinal Leo, Metropolitan Archbishop of Toronto, has been appointed by Pope Leo XIV as a member of the Vatican's Dicastery for the Clergy. The appointment does not impact Cardinal Leo's ministry as Metropolitan Archbishop of Toronto.

"The Dicastery for the Clergy deals with all matters relating to priests and deacons of the diocesan clergy, with regard to their persons and pastoral ministry, and everything needed for the fruitful exercise of the latter. In these matters, it provides suitable assistance to the Bishops. The Dicastery is responsible for promoting all that concerns the training of future clerics by issuing appropriate norms, such as the Ratio Fundamentalis Institutionis Sacerdotalis and the Ratio Fundamentalis Institutionis Diaconorum Permanentium, as well as other documents regarding ongoing formation."

We pray for His Eminence and all those appointed to the Dicastery for the Clergy. May they be guided by the Holy Spirit in their discernment to support priests and deacons throughout the world.
