#### ANGEL TREE



Our annual parish Angel Tree program which assists needy families in our community at Christmas, is more urgent than ever before, due

to continuous rising costs which have made meeting basic needs unaffordable for many families.

As in past years, we are organizing the Angel Tree in the foyer and will have tags identifying the age and gender of children from needy families we will be assisting at Christmas.

This year, we shall be helping:

- families served by the St. Vincent de Paul Society of our parish
- outreach assistance to the homeless served by the Good Shepherd Ministries in Toronto
- families served by the Catholic Children's Aid Society.

In order to empower the parents to provide a meaningful gift to their children, St. Vincent de Paul requests the giving of store gift cards, whereas the Catholic Children's Aid prefers gifts as mentioned on the tags. For Good Shepherd, gift cards are indicated on the tags; we will use the gift cards to shop for warm winter clothing to be sent down to Good Shepherd for distribution to those in need.

Members will be on hand to receive your gifts or gift cards following all Sunday Masses **Nov. 29/30** and **Dec. 6/7**. Please return your donation no later than **12:00** noon on **December 7**.

In addition to the Angel Tree, please remember we have the special St. Vincent de Paul collection on the weekend of **December 6**<sup>th</sup>/7<sup>th</sup>, as another option of supporting the poor and needy at Christmas.
