A reading from the Gospel according to Matthew 25:31-40

Jesus said to his disciples,
'When the king comes in glory, he will sit on his throne with all the angels around him. All the people of the world will come to him, and he will separate them just like a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats.

When did we give you clothes to wear?
When did we see you sick or in prison and come to visit you?"

'And the King will answer, "When you do those things for any of my brothers and sisters in need, you do it to me. And those who do these things will live with God forever."
