A reading from the Gospel according to John 1:35-42

When John the Baptist was in Bethany  
With two of his disciples, he saw Jesus walking by, and said,  
“Look! There is the Lamb of God!”

The two disciples who were with John  
Heard what he said and began to follow Jesus.  
When Jesus turned around and saw them following him  
He asked them,  
“What do you want?”

They answered,  
“Rabbi (this word means teacher), where do you live?”

Jesus said,  
“Come and see!”  
So they went with Jesus,  
Now, it was about 4 o’clock in the afternoon  
And so they stayed with him for the rest of that day.

One of the two who followed him was Andrew,  
The brother of Simon Peter.  
So the next morning, the first thing Andrew did was find his  
brother Simon and tell him,

“We have found the Messiah!  
When Andrew brought Simon to Jesus,  
Jesus looked at him and said,  
“You are Simon, the son of John.  
But from now on you will be called Peter.”
