try to spread the word of God.

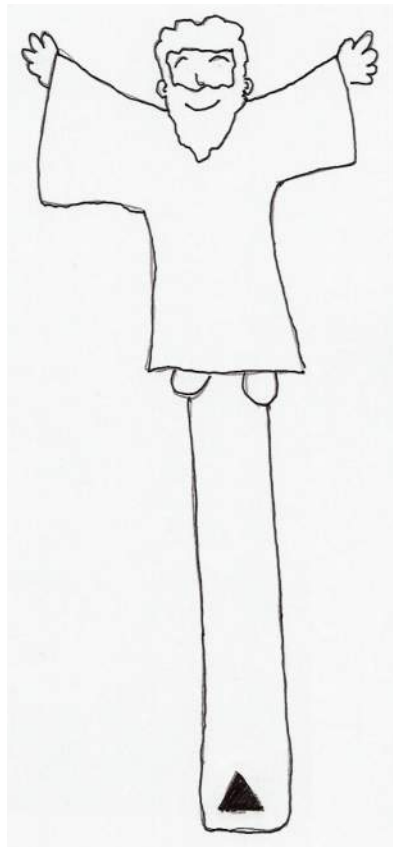


Notice how the
